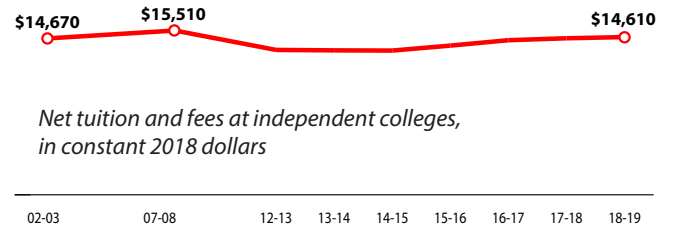

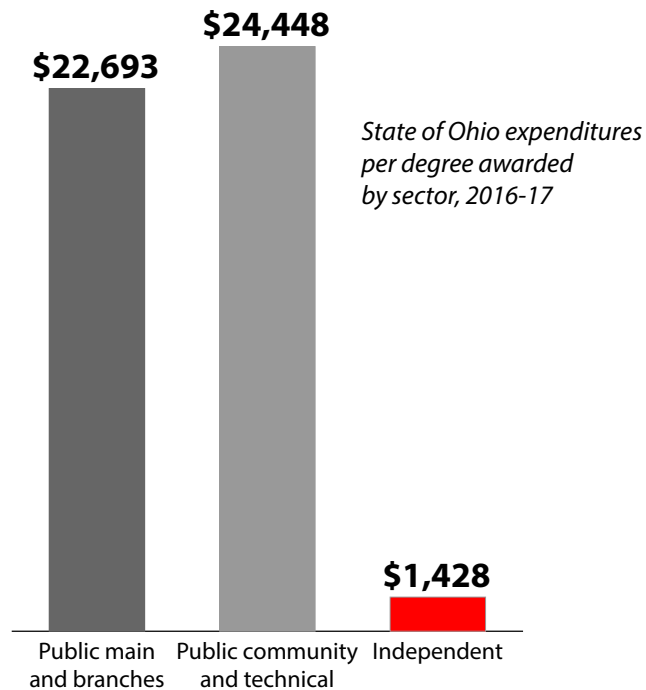
Graduation rates for Ohio independent, public institutions

Holding the Line on Net Costs



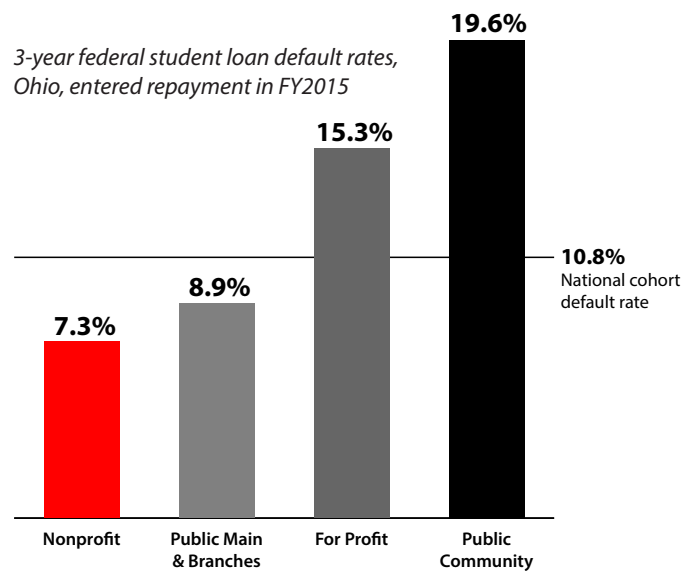
Net tuition and fees at independent colleges,

by sector, 2016-17

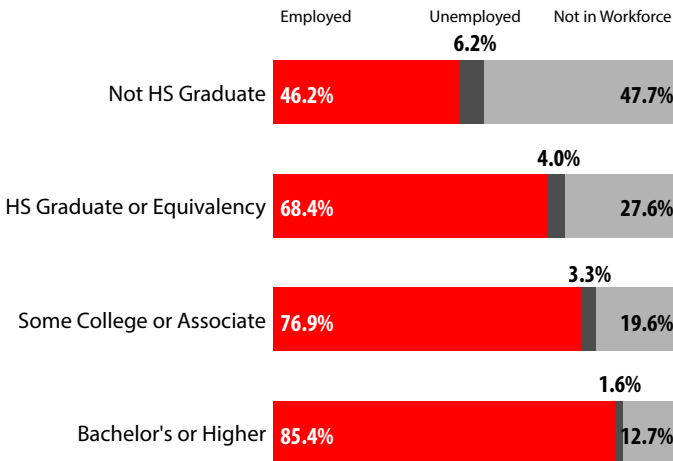
More Likely to be Employed, So Least Likely to Default



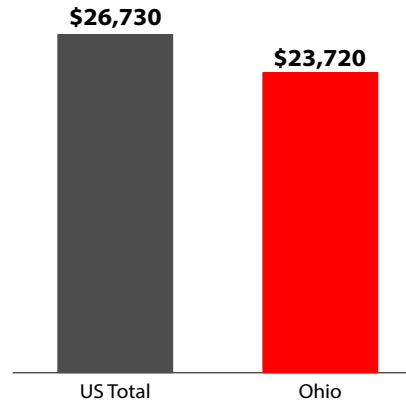
3-year federal student loan default rates,

Ohio workforce participation rates, by education, 2017



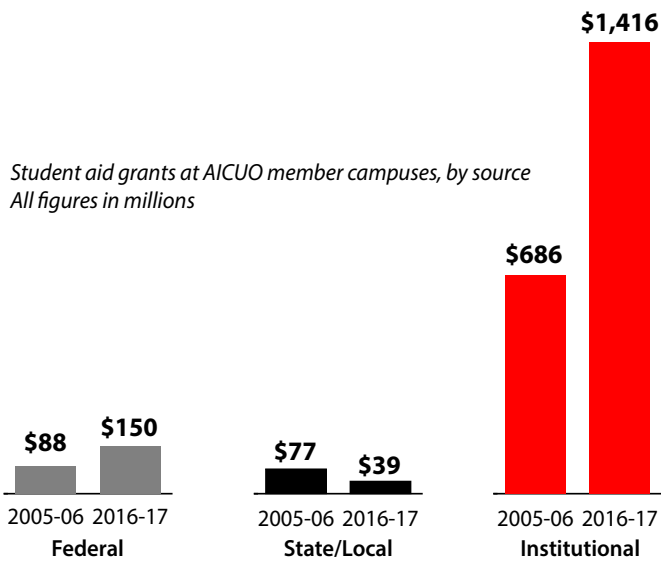
Costs Less Than the US Average



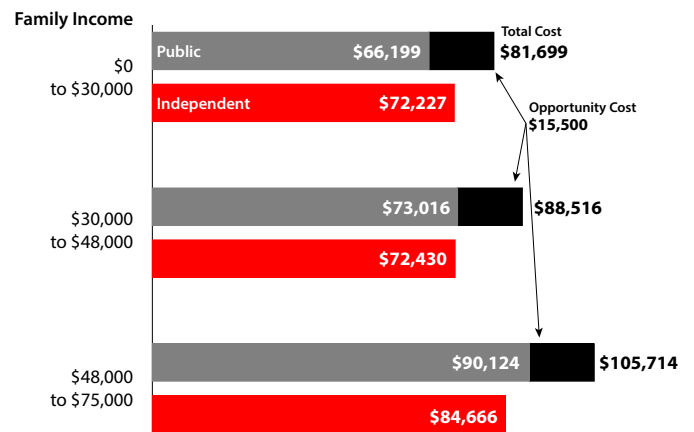
Average net price for first-time first-year undergraduates for 2016-17, including room, board, and other expenses

All figures in millions

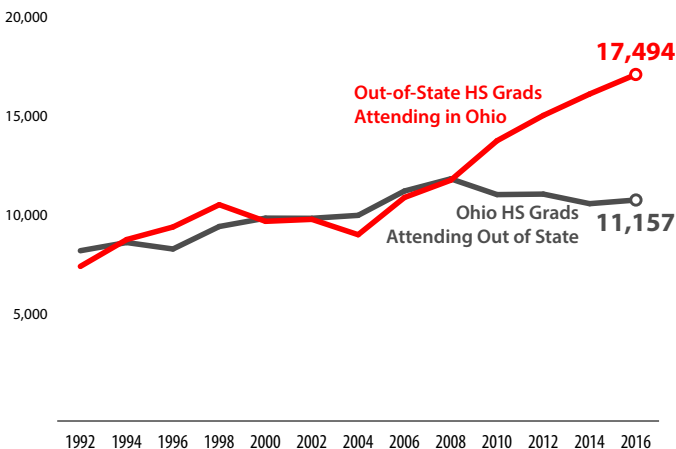


More Cost Effective Degrees
